



WORKERS' COMPENSATION INJURIES

Please follow the steps below when injured and present your PURPLE CARD

Injuries for <u>Occupational Health</u>	Injuries for <u>Emergency Department</u> (during and after hours)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Needlesticks, eye splashes with bodily fluids • Minor cuts with controlled bleeding (no sutures needed) • Sprains and strains • Low back injuries (not significant trauma) • Repetitive stress injuries 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Needlesticks after hours • Toxic chemical exposures • Eye injury or exposure to toxic chemicals (acid/base) • Large lacerations requiring repair • Orthopedic fracture or dislocation

- Seek treatment at the facility where you are injured. If working at CCMC, seek treatment at HH.
- DO NOT PROVIDE YOUR INSURANCE CARE EVEN IF YOU ARE ASKED FOR IT. Make sure you are not listed as the guarantor, resulting in a personal financial obligation; list (CAHC as the guarantor).
- Call CAHC to report your injury (860) 676-1110 within 24 hours. If after hours, please leave a general voicemail with your name, contact number, and the specifics of your injury.
- Please notify CAHC immediately on all billing errors.
